Know all the number bonds to 10



Helpful Tips for Parents

Number Bonds to 10 are two numbers that add up to total 10

$$\begin{aligned} 0 + 10 &= 10 \\ 1 + 9 &= 10 \\ 2 + 8 &= 10 \\ 3 + 7 &= 10 \\ 4 + 6 &= 10 \\ 5 + 5 &= 10 \\ 6 + 4 &= 10 \\ 7 + 3 &= 10 \\ 8 + 2 &= 10 \\ 9 + 1 &= 10 \\ 10 + 0 &= 10 \end{aligned}$$

Use everyday opportunities to count whenever and wherever you can.

Look at the patterns for both objects and numbers – *does your child notice that as one number increases the other decreases?*

Practise with the numbers in order but then chosen randomly when your child becomes more confident.



Activity Ideas

Use your fingers to practise number bonds to 10



Sing rhymes (examples on YouTube) to help your child remember the number bonds.

Build Lego towers of 10 using two different colours

Paint a number bond rainbow.



Card Games: Write the numbers 0-10 on two sets of cards and play a memory game or snap by matching the number bonds.

Use any ten objects and split them into two groups so your child can see the number bonds more clearly.

Hide some of the objects and see if you child can work out how many you have hidden?



Key Vocabulary

add, total, how many more to make? altogether

The secret to success is practising **little and often**. Use time wisely. *Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey?*

Make it fun if possible through games and challenges. If your child is really not in the mood it is the wrong time to be practising!
