



Key Instant Recall Facts – Y4 Spring Term 1

Know multiplication and division facts for 7 & 9 times tables



Helpful Tips for Parents

Create regular, short opportunities for rapid-fire questions where an instant correct answer is required.

Encourage children to use what they already know from other times tables (e.g. 7×5 is the same as 5×7 or 3×9 is the same as 9×3)

Chanting times tables does help. Make it fun by adding actions or singing them – there are lots of different songs on YouTube.

Look for patterns with the numbers.

Remember to practise times tables randomly too – your child needs to be able to respond immediately to any times table question.

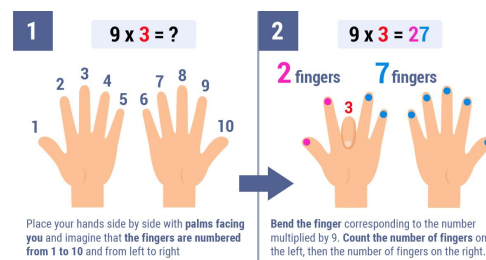
