Parent - Teacher Meetings

Harvest Festival

Each year we hold a Harvest Festival Celebration in St Mary's Church, South Walsham. Each class prepares a short presentation on an aspect of harvest. Our new children across the school are presented with a Christian book; these books are donated by St Mary's Church.

The money raised helps us to provide enrichment activities for all our pupils. Before each one, you will receive a letter inviting your child to take part.

Brothers and sisters visit the Secret Santa Room together and choose gifts jointly.
